The EU Etoxazole MRL

CGA has been tracking the status of the Etoxazole EU MRL and reflected the EU's intention to lower the citrus MRL to LOD in the CGA/CRI Recommended Usage Restrictions for Plant Protection Products on Southern African Export Citrus (No. 54 of March 2023 and No. 55 of August 2023). This process has now been formalized and all existing Etoxazole MRLs were lowered to LOD (0.01 ppm). The new MRLs will apply from 8 April, 2024; citrus fruits in the EU market at that time should comply with the new Etoxazole MRL. 1, 2
